I have a Bachelor's degree from UW-Green Bay in Global Informational Analysis. It's a personalized major that I want to emphasize — library science, computer science and business.

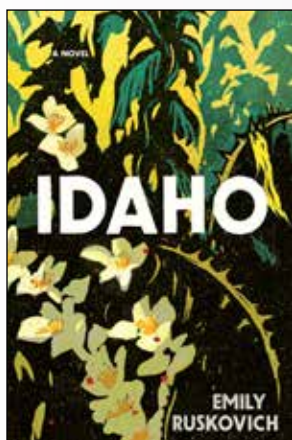
## **Collaboration Between Librarians and Bookstores**
