Every day, libraries are challenged to make greater connections to community, serve all members of a diverse population, and reach readers wherever they live — with tighter budgets, less staff or time, while taking on new technologies and cultural demands.

I have a Bachelor's degree from UW-Green Bay in Global Informational Analysis. It's a personalized major that I want to emphasize — library science, computer science and business.


Best Practices: Letting People Know About Your Large Print Collection

- **Durand Public Library Facebook:** A new edition that I just started about three years ago. On the Facebook website, I post local events and programs, and advertise the new books on Tuesdays.
