ROSE HULING



Rose Huling is the Bookmobile & Outreach Coordinator for the Morse Institute Library in Natick, Massachusetts. She holds a BS in Education from Lesley University. She has been driving the bookmobile since 2003. She also served as interim director (for 6 months) at the Bacon Free Library in South Natick, MA. Her prior experience includes two years as a

Middle School teacher for 7th Grade Social Studies and Science . . . teaching these major subjects from a cart as she moved from classroom to classroom. She also spent ten years working in the Copying/Offset Printing fields as a customer service specialist.

Rose attended a Joint Bookmobile and Outreach Conference in 2005 and found a community of kindred souls. Rose became a passionate advocate for the Association of Bookmobile & Outreach Services (ABOS) and made it her goal to get as many of the conference presentations and handouts each year to be able to share them with colleagues across the country.

In 2013, Rose received the John Philip Excellence In Outreach Award (formerly called the John Philip Award) for her leadership in the ABOS organization and the outreach community.

In September 2017, Rose was looking for a new challenge. Feeling concerned that a senior book club located in an assisted living facility was becoming leaderless yet again due to constant staff turnover, Rose decided to step in and lead the book group herself. Using the Senior Book Group Program that Thorndike Press put together, Rose had the resources, information, and support she needed. In fact, Rose is now running two senior book groups!

BEST PRACTICES: BUILDING COMMUNITY

Building community is a key component in your outreach plan. You don't need a special vehicle to do outreach. Consider yourself blessed and/or cursed if you have a bookmobile. (If you don't have a vehicle, just ignore that last sentence. LOL)

Outreach is what happens once you exit the library doors.

You are bringing the library to folks who don't generally visit the library: seniors, homebound, and those with transportation difficulties. This may be accomplished by visiting senior/community centers, senior housing, nursing homes, prisons, schools, and more.

Pamela Leffler, library director of the St. Charles Public Library in Illinois, shared this thought that really resonates with me:

"I saw how much these people needed the service that I was providing. For many of my homebound delivery patrons, their world narrowed to the facility they were in, their homes or the walls of their room. I was often the only person they would see that day or week or sometimes even month. I was doing more than just bringing them books, audiobooks or DVDs — I was bringing them the outside world. The small interactions that we had together, allowed them to feel more a part of the community."

Planning Steps:

- 1. Identify the area and population that you want to serve.
- 2. Connect with the POC (person/point of contact) for that area.
- 3. Make a preliminary visit to talk to the folks and press the flesh (shake hands).
- 4. Determine what materials you need and bring a variety of materials.
- 5. Set a regular time to visit.
