USING CHATS AND TWEETS FOR COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT

Like many librarians, I have used the EarlyWord website for several years to get advance notice about future bestsellers, books being made into movies, etc. About five years ago I started participating in the EarlyWord GalleyChat. This is a monthly "meeting" on Twitter when collection development and readers' advisory librarians across the country get together to talk about upcoming books that we are excited about. The community of librarians who participate have years of experience and very diverse reading interests, so they are very good at spotting "the next big thing" whatever the genre. GalleyChat librarians were among the first to recognize future bestsellers such as Paula Hawkins *The Girl on the Train*, Hanya Yanagihara's *A Little Life*, Andy Weir's *The Martian*, and Anthony Doerr's *All the Light We Cannot See* long before publication.

Being a part of such a smart group helps me be a smarter librarian. It alerts me to upcoming titles so we can make sure we get them ordered ahead of demand, and if we expect them to be really popular, we try to get them in a variety of formats to meet our patrons' needs. It also helps me recommend titles for our library's book group that are highly discussible but might not be on our patrons' radar. Some GalleyChat favorites that our group has discussed or will soon: *The Bees* by Laline Paull, *Smoke Gets in Your Eyes* by Caitlyn Doughty, *Everyone Brave is Forgiven* by Chris Cleave, and *The Readers of Broken Wheel* Recommend by Katarina Bivald.
