BEST PRACTICES: CHOOSING GOOD BOOKS FOR BOOK GROUPS

After reading, making the book group selections can be the most fun a facilitator can have with the book group. And yet, this process can be stressful, controversial and even political for the facilitator. Books are inanimate objects that engender animated emotions.

How can some of these emotional biblio-minefields be avoided? Here are a few things for the librarian/book group leader to keep in mind while putting together the reading list.

You are the reading expert. You see a wider variety of books and likely a larger swath of book and publishing news than your book group. This makes you the expert and your group knows this! Even if they don't say it. They really do depend on your expertise to guide them to the books they should have on their radar. Thus, when suggesting titles for the list, your vote counts. Sometimes more than once and more than other votes.

Your group likes to read and they like to share their book suggestions. They want to impress their fearless reading leader with their knowledge. But your readers probably don't view the group they way you do. They see individuals who gather to talk about a book. You see this, too, but you also see a group personality. You recognize the individual reading tastes as well as the group reading tastes. Keep this in mind while selecting titles for the group. Solicit suggestions but remember that a group member will typically put forth a title she wants to read or has read and liked. Your job is to evaluate suggestions that fit with the group's personality and preferences.

Your group likes to talk (or I hope they do). Select books that generate conversation about characters, issues, and an author's intention. Select books that stir controversy. Book groups are one of the last safe places to have difficult conversations. If your group likes to talk about characters, consider Herman Koch's The Dinner. All of the characters are realistically flawed and hiding crucial information from the others. If your group likes to talk about issues, look at From the Memoirs of a Non-Enemy Combatant. A talented young immigrant comes to the U.S. to make a career in the fashion industry and is unintentionally caught up in a federal terrorist plot. If your group wants to talk about an author's intention and/or writing style, Claudia Rankine's Citizen: An American Lyric is a great choice.

Embrace your role as a reading taste-maker for the book group. Once you start the conversation, there's no telling where it will continue once they leave the safe space of the book club.
