BEST PRACTICES: 5 PODCASTS FOR READERS ADVISORS

It's a truth universally acknowledged among readers' advisors we can't read everything.

We can't read or listen to all the books and sometimes, we can't read all the review sources in print and online that help us keep up with all the books we can't read!

One way I tackle the never-ending TBR pile is with podcasts. I like dropping in on bookish conversations with librarians, reviewers, publishers, and other professional readers. Listening to their takes on new bestsellers, under the radar backlist, and refreshing re-reads of classics helps me do two things — trim my own TBR pile and keep up with the books that buzz.

I also learn new ways to talk about books and hear about different elements of appeal from different readers. Maybe a podcaster and I have both read the same book, but possibly the podcaster is gushing about characteristics that didn't resonate with me as much as others. Now I have at least two ways to talk about a book to a potential reader.



- Just the Right Book (http://www.bookpodcast.com) Hosted by renowned independent bookseller Roxanne Coady listeners get publishing insights, book news, and interviews with A-list authors.
- So Many Damn Books (http://www.somanydamnbooks. com) Christopher and Drew like books. And drinks. And frequently combine the two with fun banter about the publishing industry, their towering TBR piles, interviews with up and coming authors, and an eye for the backlist.
