	ake sure the material aligns with the age and developmental level of your udents. Check for a grade or reading level.
4	Is it Accessible?
or	neck that the material is accessible to all students, including those with disabilities special needs. Look for alternative formats or appropriate accommodations that hable accessibility for all, like translations and text-to-speech technology.
E	Is it Safe to Access?
to	onfirm the content is available on a resource that is safe for students and adheres strict privacy guidelines. Look for a privacy policy that confirms student data is ot collected.
•	Is it Culturally Sensitive?
М	ake sure the content promotes inclusivity and respect for diverse perspectives, ultures, and identities.
E	Is it Engaging?
	ook for multimedia elements, interactive features, and varied instructional rategies you can use to engage students and enhance learning.
