

Biography and Genealogy Master Index on the *Gale Directory Library* platform is ideal for genealogical research, giving users the ability to cross-reference content in both resources in a single step.

Biography and Genealogy Master Index contains more than 20 million bibliographic citations spanning many decades. As a reference standard, it indexes 2,000+ biographical and genealogical sources that cover living and deceased persons from every field of activity, from 150+ countries.

Not only does it list basic information about an individual, but the citations also point to where a written history can be found. While it focuses on late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, it also expands to biographies about a large number of early Americans who immigrated to North America in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries—with local histories included among the indexed sources.

Biography and Genealogy Master Index can help answer genealogy-related questions like:

- Where can I find information about my great-great grandfather's rank in the Civil War Confederate Army? His name is John W. Woolley.
- My ancestor's name is Anthony Burns, and I think he was a slave. Where can I find more information about him?
- My ancestor's name was Stephen Hopkins, he was a signer of the Declaration of Independence. I think he might have also been a governor. Where can I find out if that's true?
